

Computing Non-Negotiables

General

1. Computing will be taught as follows:
 - Key Stage 1 – 1 lesson every week.
 - Key Stage 2 – taught for alternate half terms and blocked against Art and Design.
2. Kapow will be used to plan and deliver Computing lessons.
3. Children will record their learning in their online folders as appropriate

Structure of the Curriculum

4. The overall structure of lessons will follow Kapow.
5. The process should be flexible, allowing children to return to previous stages once they have evaluated their work.
6. Online safety should be taught in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2 at least once every term using the Kapow units.

Presentation of Computing work

7. Work from every unit will be saved in the pupil folder in the shared areas.
8. Worksheets are available on Kapow as needed.
9. Units of learning must conclude with the quiz questions.

Assessment

10. Teachers must complete the assessment quiz for each unit.
11. Teachers must use verbal feedback throughout the learning process.
