Dear Families,

December has been full of performances at Combs Ford Primary School in the lead up to Christmas. The Rock Steady gig showcased the musical talents of our budding rock stars and all the children, from Year 1 to Year 6, took part in our annual Christmas Service at St Mary's Church, Combs led by Reverend Sarah Jenkins. The children and staff worked incredibly hard to make all of these such a success. In amongst all of this, Year 4 managed to squeeze in a visit to Colchester Castle to look at the impact of the Roman invasion of the imperial province they called Britannia. 

We raised an incredible £372 for the school!









UNICEF Rights Respecting School Update

The Rights Respecting journey at Combs Ford is well and truly underway and we are excited to let you know that we have been awarded our first award from UNICEF – we are now a 'Rights Committed: Bronze School.' The children have shown amazing enthusiasm, maturity and curiosity within this project and should feel incredibly proud of this achievement.

Earlier this month, the children spent a fun afternoon exploring the UN Convention on the rights of the child. As part of this, the children were asked to design a Combs Ford Rights Respecting Mascot.
