


A few things to remember:

- If I park here, am I blocking a dropped curb so people can't easily cross the road or see enough to cross the road safely?
- If I park here, can other drivers see enough to be able to access Bures close and see people crossing the road?

Book Winners!



Rewilding the School Grounds



Well done Year 6 – we know you'll have been telling your many stories of what you experienced and what you achieved.








Year 6 at School


