This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing 'a_e' saying /ai/.




Top Tip

'a_e' is a split digraph. To remember this, we say that **a** and **e** are cheeky partners. When **a** and **e** work together, they say /ai/. Because **a** and **e** are too cheeky to sit together, they must have a letter sit between them to 'split' them, e.g. ate, cake, name.
