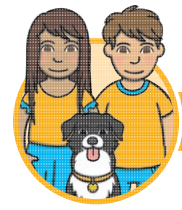


This week, we have been learning to read and spell words with the suffix **-ed**.

Top Tip

The suffix **-ed** goes at the end of a root verb. It changes the verb from present tense to past tense, e.g. 'jump' becomes 'jumped', 'gasp' becomes 'gasped'.

Formation

-ed

Finish at the red dot.

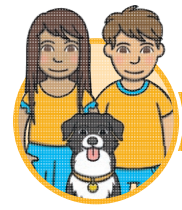

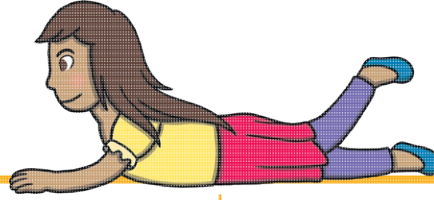
