

This week, we are learning to read and spell words containing 'ie' saying /igh/.

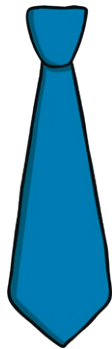

Top Tip

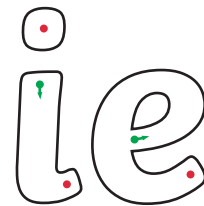
The grapheme 'ie' makes the same sound as 'igh'. It is usually at the end of short words, such as 'tie' or 'pie'.
