

Adding **-est** to words ending in **e**

When we add the suffix **-est** to words ending in **e**, we only need to add **-st**, as the **e** is already there.

nice \longrightarrow nicest

Adding **-y** to words ending in **e**

When we add the suffix **-y** to words ending in **e**, we remove the **e** before adding the **-y**.

shine \longrightarrow shiny

Common Exception Words

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **learn** and **search**.

Grammar

A statement is a type of sentence which tells you something. It has a verb and ends with a full stop, e.g.

The girl was singing in the hall.

An exclamation is another type of sentence. It must start with 'what' or 'how', have a verb and end with an exclamation mark, e.g.

What a mess we have made!
