Adding **-ed** to words ending in **e**

When we change words ending in **e** to the past tense, we take away the **e** and add **-ed**.

scoreed
jokeed

When you add **-ed** to a word that ends in **e**, the **-ed** suffix makes the /d/ or /t/ sound.

Adding **-er** to words ending in **e**

When adding **-er** to words ending in **e**, we take away the **e** and add **-er**.

hikeer
bakeer

Common Exception Words

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **whole** and **listen**.

Grammar

When we add the suffix **-ed** to verbs, it changes them to the past tense, e.g.

Sam and Kit hiked up the hill.

The past tense is when we talk about something which has already happened.
