
This week, we have been learning to read and spell words containing **ey** saying /ee/.

When **y** appears at the end of a word it usually makes an /ee/ sound.

happy jolly

y is used more often than **ey** at the end of words.

"I should have won!" (anger)

"We won!" (excitement)


