### -ment

Adding the suffix -ment turns a verb into a noun.

enjoyment payment

 -ment can usually be added straight to the root word.

#### -ness

Adding the suffix **-ness** to an adjective turns it into a noun.

softness thickness

If the root word ends in **y**, you need to replace the **y** with an **i** and then add the suffix.

happy happiness tidy tidiness

## **Common Exception Words**

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **hour** and **move**.

Sentences can often be improved and made more interesting by using descriptive verbs, adverbs or noun phrases, e.g.

The athletes ran towards the finish line.

or

The strong athletes sprinted rapidly towards the finish line.
