Common Exception Words

We have been learning to spell the common exception words prove and improve.

Grammar

We can use a **subordinating conjunction** to add extra information to a sentence. This extra bit of information is called a 'subordinate clause' and it only makes sense with the main sentence.

Subordinating conjunctions like if, as, while, after, because and when can all be used to join the extra bit of information to the main sentence.

> Zain woke up with a fright after the loud bang. She put on her coat because it was raining.





