

Music Non-Negotiables

- All music curriculum should be from Kapow! Primary music to ensure progression and continuity across the school.
- Music lessons should be taught in the music room as much as possible.
- One instrumental unit to be taught in place of one other unit in each year group in KS2.
- Make use of all of the instruments that we have to offer – please refrain from only using the glockenspiels!
- Class iPad should be taken to any music lesson with a view to capture anything amazing.
- Use green plain exercise books to record learning. This could be a place to stick in sheets that Kapow offer or to record ideas when children are responding to music.
- Final performances must be recorded on a class iPad and uploaded into the class folder on the OneDrive for each unit of work.
- Assessment is made using assessment grids taken from the Kapow! Primary assessment spreadsheet, and should be filled in once each assessment criteria has been taught (works out as one per lesson-ish).
